That is Look-up!!!

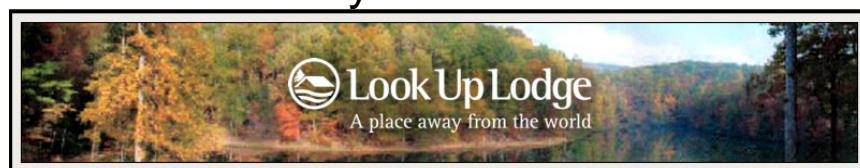
